## **Student Health Care Mellanhedsskolan**

### **Welcome to the student health care at Mellanhedsskolan**

All children in compulsory school are offered school healthcare services. The work is primarily preventive and consists of health check-ups and basic medical care efforts, special needs support or psychosocial help or guidance. In supportive interventions the health care team provides analysis and mapping of students' needs.

#### **Our school health service**

Our team consists of a school nurse, a school counselor and teachers for special needs education. The School headmistress and assistant headmasters are part of the team. The team has also, if required, collaboration with psychologists and a school doctor.

We work to ensure that children, regardless of functional ability, have adequate conditions to fulfil their educational goals. Supportive interventions take place in collaboration with the school's teachers and parents. If a child is in need of special support, the headmistress shall ensure that an action plan is developed. All children shall be given the possibility to develop according to their own individual capabilities.

### **The Education Act – the foundation for education of children**

The Swedish Education Act constitutes the basis for all education. It states that all children and youth shall have equal access to education regardless of gender, ethnicity, place of residence, or of social or economic factors. Special support shall be given to pupils who have difficulties in completing their education successfully.

Two laws, the Swedish Education Act and the Swedish Discrimination Act, help protect children and students from discrimination and degrading treatment. In essence, the principals are responsible for enforcing prohibitions against discrimination and degrading behavior, and for promoting equal treatment.

At Mellanhedsskolan we've got a comprehensive anti-discrimination action plan, that is, a plan for anti-discrimination, equality, and humanistic and non-denominational scientific values.
